

MONTGOMERY COUNTY SUPERVISORS MINUTES  
BUDGET WORK SESSION  
February 2, 2009

The Montgomery County Board of Supervisors met in quorum Monday, February 2, 2009, at 10:00 A.M. at the courthouse for their budget work session. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bryant Amos. There was a roll call of members with Supervisors Amos, Glen Benskin, Karen Blue, Steve Ratcliff, and Donna Robinson present.

Motion by Benskin, second by Ratcliff to approve the agenda. Roll call: Yes: Amos, Benskin, Blue, Ratcliff, Robinson. No: None. Motion carried.

Minutes of the January 29, 2009 regular meeting were read and stand as read.

The Chairman called for public comment. No public comment.

The Supervisors visited with Roadside Manager Damien Bond and Engineer Brad Skinner. Bond presented information on the purchase of a used chipper in fiscal year 2010.

Skinner reviewed his Amended Construction Program for fiscal year 2009 and the construction programs for the upcoming fiscal years. He reviewed the costs associated with various projects throughout the county.

Wages and salaries were reviewed and consensus of the board that all non-union county employees would receive a zero percent wage increase other than those receiving end-of-probationary-period and scheduled merit increases as presented to the Board.

Auditor Joni Ernst mentioned a few other items for consideration including a reimbursement of \$3,696 to the Montgomery County EMS Association and an increase in the Toledo Juvenile Home line item.

Motion to adjourn by Benskin, second by Ratcliff. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 11:55 A.M.
