

MONTGOMERY COUNTY SUPERVISORS MINUTES
CANVASS OF SCHOOL ELECTION
September 11, 2009

The Montgomery County Board of Supervisors met in quorum, Friday, September 11, 2009, at 8:00 a.m. at the courthouse. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bryant Amos. There was a roll call of members with Supervisors Amos, Steve Ratcliff and Donna Robinson present. Chairman Amos stated that Item #4 Regular Minutes would be removed.

Motion to approve the agenda as amended by Ratcliff, second by Benskin. Roll call: Yes: Amos, Ratcliff, Robinson. No: None. Motion carried.

Deputy Auditor, Ted Schoonover, presented the Canvass of the School Election held September 8, 2009 to the supervisors with those elected as follows;

Villisca School Board: Marvin Smith, 123 votes, Daniel Sorenson, 111 votes and Public Measure B: Yes: 125 No: 8.

Stanton School Board: Brian Bates, 72 votes, Mark Lindgren, 68 votes, Jeff Sorensen, 71 votes.

Red Oak School Board: Elizabeth R. Dilley, 90 votes, Paul M. Griffen, 96 votes, Warren C. Hayes, 99 votes and Public Measure A: Yes: 91 votes No: 7 votes.

Merged Area XIV Director, District 5: Ken Rech, 92 votes.

Motion by Ratcliff, second by Robinson to approve the Official Canvass of Votes from the School Election September 8, 2009. Roll call: Yes: Amos, Ratcliff, Robinson. No: None. Motion carried.

After approving the canvasses, the supervisors signed the abstracts of votes and certificates of election.

Motion by Ratcliff, Second by Robinson to adjourn. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 8:15am.
