

MONTGOMERY COUNTY SUPERVISORS MINUTES
October 28, 2010

The Montgomery County Board of Supervisors met in quorum, Thursday, October 28, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. at the courthouse for their regular meeting. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bryant Amos. There was a roll call of members with Supervisors Amos, Glen Benskin, Karen Blue, Donna Robinson, and Steve Ratcliff present.

Motion to approve the agenda by Benskin, second by Ratcliff. Roll call: Yes: Amos, Benskin, Blue, Ratcliff, Robinson. No: None. Motion carried.

Minutes of the October 21, 2010 regular meeting were read and stand as read.

The Chairman called for public comments. No public comment.

The Supervisors presented their weekly updates and assignments. Blue stated she attended a Red Oak Chamber and Industry Association membership appreciation supper Tuesday evening and on Wednesday attended the hospital board meeting and 4th Judicial meeting. Robinson attended a Nishna Productions meeting and a SWIPCO subcommittee meeting.

There was no Secondary Roads update.

The Chairman briefed the Board on the Law Enforcement Center meeting held Wednesday. He stated they were doing the detailed planning now, which includes flooring and shelving materials, placement of outlets, etc. Auditor Joni Ernst reviewed the proposed bonding schedule.

The ordinance proposal regarding the assignment of tax sale certificates of abandoned and public nuisance properties from Montgomery County to the City of Red Oak was discussed. Blue asked what benefit this would have to the county. Ernst stated it had been proposed by city attorney Tom Stamets, and she would see if he could meet with the Board to review the proposal.

Motion by Ratcliff, second by Benskin to set the General Election canvass for Tuesday, November 9th at 9:00 a.m. Roll call: Yes: Robinson, Amos, Benskin, Blue, Ratcliff. No: None. Motion carried.

Benskin departed the meeting at 9:30 a.m.

Motion by Robinson, second by Ratcliff, to reschedule the November 11th Board meeting to 9:00 a.m. Friday, November 12th due to the Veterans' Day holiday. Roll call: Yes: Amos, Blue, Ratcliff, Robinson. No: None. Motion carried.

Motion by Robinson, second by Ratcliff to reschedule the November 25th Board meeting to Wednesday, November 24th at 9:00 a.m. due to the Thanksgiving Day holiday. Roll call: Yes: Blue, Ratcliff, Robinson, Amos. No: None. Motion carried.

Agenda items for the next meeting include payroll and safety coordinator update.

Motion by Robinson, second by Ratcliff to adjourn. All in favor; meeting adjourned.
