

MONTGOMERY COUNTY SUPERVISORS MINUTES
BUDGET WORKSESSION
February 1, 2010

The Montgomery County Board of Supervisors met in quorum, Monday, February 1, 2010, at 10:42 a.m. at the courthouse for their budget worksession. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bryant Amos. There was a roll call of members with Supervisors Amos, Glen Benskin, Donna Robinson, Steve Ratcliff , and Karen Blue present.

Motion to approve the agenda by Benskin, second by Ratcliff. Roll call: Yes: Amos, Ratcliff, Robinson, Benskin, Blue. No: None. Motion carried.

The Chairman called for public comments. There were no audience comments.

The Board moved into their budget worksession and discussed the proposed cuts with Conservation Board members Kirk Requist and Darold Swanson and Conservation Director Richard Price. Price presented a powerpoint presentation which outlined conservation projects and activities in Montgomery County. The Conservation Board is asking the Supervisors to consider a compromise reduction of \$16,600 total to their budget instead of the \$23, 350 as requested. The conservation representatives noted that if they are held to the \$23,350, they would not have the means to keep part-time help and would not be able to mow around the Secondary Roads sheds and Price would not be able to work as the Sanitarian. The Board stated they would look at the budget numbers on Thursday and review all of the reductions to see if a compromise could be made.

Motion by Benskin , second by Ratcliff to adjourn. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 12:05 p.m.
