

MONTGOMERY COUNTY SUPERVISORS MINUTES
CANVASS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION
June 15, 2010

The Montgomery County Board of Supervisors met in quorum, Tuesday, June 15, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. at the courthouse for the canvass of the Primary Election. The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Karen Blue. There was a roll call of members with Supervisors Blue, Glen Benskin, and Steve Ratcliff present. Chairman Bryant Amos and Supervisor Donna Robinson were absent.
